PRESS RELEASE-CLASS-X RESULT

BACKGROUND

The Central Board of Secondary Education in view of the increasing number of covid-19 cases in the country, vide notification dated 14.04.2021 cancelled the Board Examinations for class-x to be held from 04th May, 2021. The notification also mentioned that:-

- (a) Results of class X board will be prepared on the bases of an objective criterion to be developed by the Board, and
- (b) Any candidate who is not satisfied with the marks allocated will be given an opportunity to appear in an exam as and when the conditions are conducive to hold the examinations.

MODE OF ASSESSMENT

As per the information available, schools have conducted examinations in different modes and in different numbers of Class XII for session 2020 – 2021. Also due to school closure, most of the classes and examinations were conducted online by the schools. After detailed deliberations and testing the policy formula on data, committee suggested the following for preparing result:-

ACCURACY AND FAIRNESS IN RESULTS


To ensure the accuracy and fairness of the results, a Result Committee was also constituted by each school. This Result Committee consisted of 08 members i.e. 1 Principal, 5 Subject teachers and 02 external members.

HELPING HAND

To facilitate the preparation of timely results, CBSE provided full support to the schools in understanding the policy and preparation of fair and correct result. The measures undertaken were as follows:

1. An online webinar was conducted to explain the Tabulation Policy. This webinar was viewed by more than 90000 teachers. This was a live program on the YouTube wherein after explaining the policy, queries of the schools were also resolved by the CBSE.

- Queries received on email, WhatsApp and on phone were converted into Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) and uploaded on website and sent to all the schools by CBSE with the help of E-sandesh of the CBSE.
- 3. Several other webinars were convened with the help of Sahodaya School Complex of the CBSE to help the schools time and again.
- 4. An email was meant specially to address the problems of the schools pertaining to class-X result.
- 5. A help desk was setup by the CBSE in Examination Department to assist the Committee.
- 6. Several meetings were conducted with the Regional Offices wherein the queries received by the Regional Offices from the schools were resolved.
- 7. City Coordinators were briefed by the Regional Offices about the policy and further guidance as required by the schools.
- 8. Calls received on mobile number of the officials were also responded.

CONDUCT OF COMPARTMENT EXAMINATION

CBSE has taken a decision that examination will be conducted by the Board after declaration of result between 16th August, 15th September, the dates of these examinations will be announced soon.

DISPUTE SETTELMENT

It is informed that shortly a detailed process will be communicated to the students in case they are having any dispute regarding their result preparation.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. As per practice of the Board, no merit list will be prepared by the Board for Class X 2021 result.
- 2. As a special case, the Board will neither declare subject wise 0.1 merit list of students and nor issue merit certificates to the students
- 3. CBSE will be issuing a combined mark-sheet cum certificate this time to the students of Class XII in place of separate mark-sheet and passing certificate.

CBSE extend a thanks to the Principals, Teachers and other staff involved in the preparation of results for following the instructions issued by CBSE and preparing the result with the help of policy.

CBSE also wishes all the students good luck for their future.


