This activity enhances the confidence of the participants, helps in improving articulation and inculcate leadership qualities. It enables the participants to strongly put forward their view point and also inspire the listeners with their point of view on the given topic.

An online declamation competition was organized for the students of class VII on 9th of January, 2021, at 1.30 pm.

- Each contestant was asked to speak for maximum two minutes on any of the given topics.
- The contestant was also expected to introduce himself/herself in not more than 30 seconds within the given time limit.

Students were judged on the basis of following attributes:

- Clarity on content
- Presentation skill

- Confidence
- Vocabulary/Fluency

Topics given for the competition were:

- 1. Martin Luther's famous speech 'I have a dream'.
- 2. 'Leadership cannot be taught' by Peter Drucker.
- 3. 'Terrorists are not prisoners of war' by Council of Europe.
