12th April 2021
Health and Hygiene Week

School is a place for holistic development of the students. Good habits are formed during the formative years in school which last a lifetime. To promote a feeling of unity and discipline among the students, health and hygiene week will be conducted.

The students must be neatly dressed for the same during their online classes. Nails must be trimmed and hair cut must be neat as per the school rules.

The cleanliness week will begin with the EVS/ Science teacher's session on the importance of personal hygiene followed by an interactive session. Parents must also stress on the importance of hygiene and let the children make their personal hygiene kit in which they can put their tooth brush, paste, sanitizer, comb, etc. Students must get a haircut and trim nails if required.

The teachers and parents will encourage children to interact with the people around them about the importance of hygiene stressing on its importance during the Covid period.
