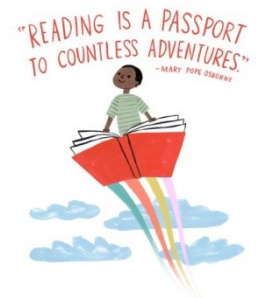

**17<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**Class III**

**Book Review Competition-The Critique**

The interested candidates have to read a children's book of any type and submit Book Review (Photograph - beautifully written on a colourful sheet as well as Video of approximately 2-3 minutes) to the English teacher on the day of the competition. The review should contain the title of the book, the author's name, a brief summary of the plot and the participant's views on what they have read.

Interested students must give their name to the class teacher on or before 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

They will be judged on the following parameters: -

- Introduction /Beginning
- Summary/Body, Evaluation/Critical Analysis, Conclusion/Ending
- Presentation- Delivery Style, Eye Contact, Body language, Speech and Volume

**12<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**Classes L.K.G -III**

**Road Safety Week**

The week will begin with the EVS/ Science teacher's session on the importance of Road Safety followed by an interactive session. Parents must also stress on the same. The teachers and parents will encourage children to interact with the family about the importance of road safety and following traffic rules. Related worksheets will be provided. **Class LKG and UKG**

The students will send a picture along with a short video (about 10 to 20 seconds) enacting one road safety rule to the class teacher. They will also be given worksheets to colour and have fun.

**Class I**

**20<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**News Room Live- News Reporting**

The participants have to dress up like reporters and present news (Weather, Entertainment, Sports, Human interest, etc.) preferably in English and send a video of approximately 2-3 minutes along with the photograph to the class teacher on the day of the competition.

Interested students must give their names to the class teacher on or before 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021. They will be judged on the following parameters: - News Value, Dress up, Overall Presentation.

**29<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**All About Me**

The participants have to give a presentation on self using references, objects, photographs, etc. and send a video of approximately 2-3 minutes along with their photograph to the class teacher on the day of the competition.

Interested students must give their names to the class teacher on or before 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021. They will be judged on the following parameters: - Introduction, Props, and Overall Presentation.

**30<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**Class I**

**The Greatest Joy of All**

The participants have to give a presentation on their family and send a video of approximately 2-3 minutes along with the photograph to the class teacher on the day of the competition.

Interested students must give their names to the class teacher on or before 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021. They will be judged on the following parameters: - Introduction, Confidence and Overall Presentation.

**31<sup>st</sup> July 2021**

**Class II**

**Read Out Loud- Extemporaneous Reading**

Content for reading will be given to the students on the day of the competition which will be conducted online via Zoom by the English teachers. Interested students must give their names to the English teacher on or before 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021. They will be judged on the following parameters: - Pronunciation, Punctuation, Fluency/Clarity and Overall Impact.

Note: -

All the participants must send clear photographs with good background to the class teacher. They will be uploaded on the website as well used for videos, magazines, etc. after screening.

All the children who participate are winners in innumerable ways. In order to give everyone a chance at winning we do not repeat winners in competitions which fall under same category.
