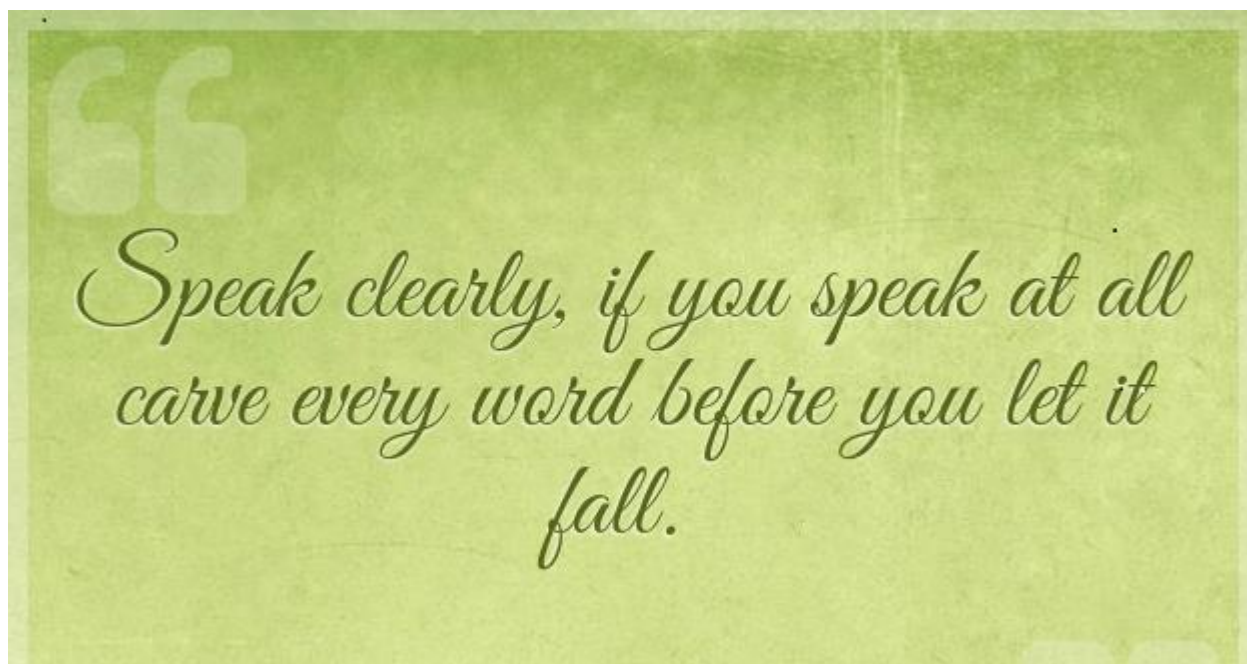


## EVENT REPORT
