

MATHS MARATHON COMPETITION

For students striving to excel in the field of mathematics, math competitions offer an easy avenue for highlighting their skills and talent.

Taking this into consideration, the school organized a **“Math Marathon”** competition for the students of class **IV**.

The competition was divided into four rounds:

- 1. First Round (8th August):** In this round a worksheet was sent and student had to reply with the correct answers in 10 minutes. The students with highest scores were selected.
- 2. Second Round (10th August):** The 15 shortlisted students from first Round were shown two questions ,each on Power Point Presentation and they had to answer them in 90 seconds. The students with maximum number of marks were selected for the third round.
- 3. Third Round (10th August):** The five shortlisted students from the above round were shown one question, each through a presentation and they had to answer it within the time frame of 1 minute
- 4. Fourth Round (10th August):** The selected students from the above round were shown Mathematical Riddles and the positions were declared according to their scores.

The result of the competition is as follows.
