FIRST ROUND: Each team was asked two questions on Geography. Each correct answer was awarded 5 marks.

SECOND ROUND: This was a visual round held in three parts. In the first part, each team was shown a visual concerning GK and a question related to it was asked which carried 5 marks. Similarly, in the second part, each team was shown a visual concerning SCIENCE and in the third part, they were shown pictures from their English Literature lessons and 2 questions were asked related to each visual clue.

THIRD ROUND: This was a rapid fire round where one student from each team was chosen to answer the questions. One minute was given to each team to answer as many as possible. Each correct answer carried 5 marks whereas a wrong answer took away 2 marks from their score.
