

Spell 'O' Well Competition - Grade IV

After successfully conducting this competition with fifth graders now it's time to test the fourth graders who were keen to participate in the competition at large from every section. But keeping in mind the format of the competition we had to select the best two from each section respectively.

Subject Teachers took the initiative as directed to conduct the **First Round** of the competition at class level to pass on the best two contestants for the Final Round to be held after two days.

Further the competition comprised of **Four Rounds** as follows:

1. **Listen and Spell** – an audio clip was played to each and every contestant and they were supposed to spell the word. Time allotted was 30 seconds.
2. **Jumbled Words** – the participants were given jumbled words to unscramble and spell it correctly. Time allotted was 40 seconds.
3. **Picture Recognition Round** – an image was shown to each one of them to recognize and spell it correctly. Time allotted was 30 seconds.
4. **Words Worth Round** – all the participants were given a word to derive multiple words out of it with a condition that it should be minimum three letter word. Time allotted was 60 seconds.
